Signs Your Clutch Cable Needs Replacing

Problems Shifting - You will know you need to replace your clutch cable if your car won't shift while the clutch is engaged, signaling that the cable is stretched beyond its limit or broken.

Slipping Gear - Occurs when the car pops out of gear without depressing the clutch or moving the shifter.

Stuck Clutch Pedal - A clutch pedal may become stuck, and this can happen while you are depressing the pedal and the cable suddenly snaps. The pedal will remain stuck and inoperable, signaling the cable needs replacing.

Noise - After inspecting your clutch system and discovering unusual noises, this could mean the cable is damaged causing clutch fork vibration among other issues, requiring replacement of the cable.
